























Regional Communities and Civil Society Consultation on the Next Global Fund Strategy

DATE: 9 December 2020

TIME: 14h - 16h (Bangkok); 12.30h - 14.30h (Delhi); 13.30h - 15.30h (Yangon); 15h - 17h (Manila)

BACKGROUND:

The Global Fund Strategy is a multi-year reference for the Fund's strategic direction, setting out priorities for how it supports responses against HIV, tuberculosis and malaria and contributes to improving global health. More than halfway through the Strategy 2017-2022, the Global Fund has now started the process for developing the next Strategy.

A virtual regional community and civil society consultation, as part of a broader regional CS Engagement Roadmap,¹ will be co-convened by APCASO/APCRG and GFAN Asia Pacific, and in partnership with regional key populations and CSO networks and platforms: ACT! AP, Regional Malaria CSO Platform, GMS, APN+, APNSW, APTN, ICW AP, ANPUD, YVC, and Youth Lead. The consultation will contribute to the set of objectives outlined in the Engagement Roadmap and aim to support effective community and civil society engagement and input in the strategy development process from the region.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To share and update the communities and civil society in Asia-Pacific on the post-2022 Global Fund Strategy development process;
- 2. To facilitate an inclusive virtual consultation process to discuss and collect feedback from AP communities and civil society on the emerging themes for the post-2022 Strategy of the Global Fund; and
- 3. To develop an AP communities and CS position statement based on the outcomes of the virtual consultation and other related GF engagement processes.

KEY OUTPUTS:

- 1. A consultation report, including key recommendations, input and perspectives on the direction of the post-2022 Strategy from communities and CS stakeholders from the region; and
- 2. A regional communities and CS position statement on GF post-2022
